Dear Parents,

We will travel to Crow's Neck Environmental Center in Tishomingo, Mississippi, on April 4 – 6, 2011, for our participation in a science fieldwork based enrichment study. The activities are designed to create an in-depth educational experience to promote the development of responsible stewardship of land and resources.

We plan to leave by 8:30 a.m. or so on April 4, and return close to 3:00 p.m. on April 6, 2011. We have chartered a bus for both the trip down and the trip back. WCA teachers will serve as chaperones, and we will need 6 more parent chaperones. The exact number of men and women will depend upon student enrollment for next fall. Some of our chaperones will need to drive their cars down as well. If you would like to go as a chaperone, please contact Mrs. Newman at Cynthia.Newman@wca-hsv.org by December 2010. **Priority will be given to parents of children with serious health concerns such as diabetes, epilepsy, severe asthma, etc., and we will not make a final decision on the chaperones until January 2011.** If we have more chaperone requests than we need, extra chaperones may attend for a fee of approximately \$200.

Crow's Neck Environmental Center is located in a beautiful setting in northeast Mississippi. Meals are served in a cafeteria, and students are supervised by camp staff members and/or WCA chaperones in the daytime. Students will participate in a variety of planned group activities, and they will be busy learning and having fun at the same time! At night, students are supervised by WCA chaperones. Sleeping facilities are very nice with central heat and air.

A complete supply list will be furnished along with the permission and health slips after school starts. The supply list will also include items that students are not allowed to bring, such as cell phones. We understand that this may cause some concern for our parents, so we will instruct our chaperones to allow students to borrow a cell phone for a quick call home if needed. Rest assured that we will contact you if we have any concerns about your child. Please notify us of any special student health need that needs extra attention by the camp staff. They are very experienced with dealing with various medical concerns.

We are looking forward to working with you and your children next year. May you enjoy God's blessings for a wonderful summer!
